For most adults, summer arrives without a lot of change. Sure, the days are longer, and I do love those long evenings playing outside with my grandkids.

But for many children, summer brings a sort of change they look to not with joy, but dread. That's because the closing of the school doors

also comes with the end of the free or reduced-price breakfasts and lunches so many children rely upon. A few meal programs do operate in the summer, but in Santa Cruz County, nearly 9,000 kids who count on free or reduced-price lunches will miss out on them for three long months.

That's where Second Harvest comes in. Our Food For Children program has been running year-round for 20 years now. Whatever school district they're in, however deep their need for food is, families in need can pick up dry-food staples and fresh produce at 48 sites across the county.

You can't overestimate how important this food is. Healthy futures require rich and active summers, and getting enough food is critical to kids' ability to learn, explore, and grow.

And that food has to be healthy—crackers in the back of the cupboard don't cut it, no matter how filling they are. That's why Second Harvest invests so much effort in acquiring and distributing fresh produce. Children need nutritious food to feed their bodies and minds, enabling them to pursue life's opportunities—and chase their friends around the park on a long summer evening.

Policy Matters

The proposals in the President's recent budget represent the most significant threats to the federal nutrition safety net in decades. The proposed cuts to nutrition programs would cause the loss of at least 45 billion meals over 10 years across the country.

Food banks like Second Harvest keep thousands in our communities from going hungry, but SNAP/CalFresh (formerly known as food stamps) is the first line of defense against hunger—food banks could not possibly provide the meals that this budget would eliminate.

Our response at this moment is critical to make it clear that such proposals will not be acceptable as Congress begins their FY18 budget process.
