Since the Second Harvest Food Bank can buy three healthy meals for \$1, that makes it more possible for many of us to buy a whole year's worth of healthy meals for a:

Single-person household: \$365

Two-person household: \$730

Three-person household: \$1,095

- Four-person household: \$1,460
- BONUS: Count your pets in your calculation! :^)
