## Pickup Etiquette Reminder

We wanted to remind our agency network to please retrieve any pickup orders that are submitted to us on the date that they are requested. Orders that are not picked up create challenges and disrupt the workflow of our Operations and Programs staff.

- If your agency places a pickup order, please ensure that it is collected promptly.
- If you encounter a scheduling conflict, please communicate the delay to our Agency Network Team as soon as possible to make the arrangements needed for a new pickup date.

Communication is essential, and we will be scheduling a meeting with agencies that have missed consecutive pickup orders.

### Community Food Co-op at Pajaro Middle School:

We are excited to share that, as part of our partnership with the Pajaro Valley Unified School District and the Monterey Community Foundation, we will now be able to support families that have students enrolled at

Pajaro Middle School. We have officially opened a Community Food Co-op at the Pajaro Resource Center, similar to the one that has been successfully supporting families who have a child enrolled in the PVUSD school system at the Wellness Center by EA Hall Middle School.
